Tour the historic battlefield where the famous Battle of Culloden took place on April 16, 1746. This was the final confrontation of the Jacobite Rising, where the Jacobite forces of Charles Edward Stuart (known as "Bonnie Prince Charlie") were decisively defeated by the British government army led by the Duke of Cumberland.
- CLAVA CAIRNS**
Tour the prehistoric burial site, which was built around 4,000 years ago. The site has passage graves, ring cairns, and standing stones arranged in a specific alignment, likely connected to solar events like winter solstice.

Afternoon Tea Enjoy a traditional afternoon tea at Dornoch.
- 1:55pm** **DUNROBIN CASTLE**
Touring Tour one of the most historic castles in the Scottish Highlands. This castle is the ancestral home of the Earls and Dukes of Sutherland, one of Scotland's most powerful clans.

This is a photographic Paradise.</p> <p>FORT AUGUSTUS and FORT WILLIAM At Fort Augustus, you might just catch a glimpse of Nessie or more likely, boats navigating the series of locks along the Caledonian Canal. Fort William sits at the foot of Ben Nevis, the tallest mountain in the British Isles. It's also a good vantage point for Neptune's Staircase, a series of eight canal locks.</p>

The castle sits atop Castle Hill, an intrusive crag, which forms part of the Stirling Sill geological formation. It is surrounded on three sides by steep cliffs, giving it a strong defensive position.
1:00pm Touring	SCONE PALACE AND GARDENS This site was originally the site of any early Christian church, and later an Augustinian priory. Scone Abbey, in the grounds of the Palace, for centuries held the famous Stone of Scone upon which the early Kings of Scotland were crowned. Enjoy lunch on your own at the palace.
