

Vietnam eVisa Instructions 2026

Prior to starting the application, make sure you have a photo of your passport main page, without glare and with all corners visible, and a passport style photo saved in .jpg format that you can upload as part of the application process. Examples of these photos types are below:



1. Click Apply now and confirm that you'll comply with Vietnam laws and confirmation that you read the instructions.
2. On the next page, you'll need to upload the picture of your passport main page as well as a passport style photo.
3. Questions that require answers are:
 - a. Surname
 - b. Middle and Given Name
 - c. Date of Birth
 - d. Sex
 - e. Nationality
 - f. Email
 - g. Religion
 - h. Place of Birth (match your passport birth place. The example above would be Washington D.C., USA.
 - i. Answer the three questions that include:
 - i. Have you ever used any other passports to enter into Viet Nam?
 - ii. Do you have multiple nationalities?
 - iii. Violation of the Vietnamese laws/regulations?

- j. Select either a Single Entry or Multi-Entry Visa based on your needs. For our tour if you are not travelling through Vietnam before we begin in Siem Reap, Cambodia, you can select a Single Entry. However, if you are stopping in Hanoi or other parts of Vietnam before coming to the Brand g program, you should select a Multi-Entry Visa.
- k. Enter your Passport Number, Issuing Authority (For US Passports this is the United States Department of State), Passport Type (Ordinary for most), Date of Issue, and Expiry Date.
- l. Contact Information
 - i. Permanent Residential Address, where the entire address is entered on one line, such as 123 Main, New York, NY 10307
 - ii. Contact Address, which may be the same address you entered in the Permanent Residential Address field.
 - iii. Telephone Number
 - iv. Emergency Contact Name
 - v. Emergency Contact Residential Address, where the entire address is entered on one line such as 123 Main, New York, NY 10307
 - vi. Emergency Contact Telephone Number
 - vii. Emergency Contact Relationship (such as Friend, Spouse, Father, Sister)
- m. Occupation Information is not required but can be optionally provided.
- n. Information about the trip
 - i. Purpose of Entry – Tourism
 - ii. Intended Date of Entry – 07/01/2026 (January 7th is the date we'll enter Vietnam on the Mekong River.
 - iii. Intended Length of Stay in Viet Nam – Enter number of days you'll stay in Vietnam. You can add extra days to the number, as long as you plan to leave on or before the number of days you enter.
 - iv. Residential Address in Vietnam – You can enter the Hotel Address that we'll stay at in Ho Chi Minh City as follows: 22 – 36 Nguyen Hue, Ben Nghe, Quan 1, Ho Chi Minh, Vietnam
 - v. The Province/City – Ho Chi Minh City
 - vi. Ward/Commune – Sai Gon Ward
 - vii. Intended border gate at entry – Vinh Xuong Landport
 - viii. Intended Border Gate of Exit – If you're leaving the country from Ho Chi Minh City, enter the Tan Son Nhat Int Airport (Ho Chi Minh City). For those of you leaving the country in Hanoi, choose the Noi Bai Int Airport.

- o. Trips Expenses, Insurance – Are not required and you can leave these blank.
 - p. Check the declaration, and click Next.
- 4. You'll have an opportunity to review the completed application and have to enter a numeric code /Captch into a security code box to proceed.
- 5. Your Completed declaration will be assigned number. Print this screen, and proceed to the payemt screen.
- 6. Click the "Pay by Visa / Mastercard / JCB / AMEX" screen and enter your credit card information.
 - a. Click Continue
 - b. Click I agree.
 - c. You may need to click Continue again.
 - d. You'll receive a Payment Success screen once successful. You'll also receive an email confirmation.
- 7. You'll receive an email once the visa is granted with a link to log back into the website and download the Visa.
